### **Governor Charlie Baker's Schedule for Wednesday, March 4, 2020**

**BOSTON** – Tomorrow, Governor Charlie Baker, Lt. Governor Karyn Polito, Secretary of Health and Human Services Marylou Sudders and Commissioner of the Department of Public Health Monica Bharel will meet with senior public health officials, executives from the MBTA and Massport, and leaders representing institutions on the front-line of the preparedness planning for Coronavirus to discuss the process underway in Massachusetts. This group will include local boards of health, hospitals and first responders.

Following the meeting, the group will hold a media availability.

Later, Governor Baker and Lt. Governor Polito will join Secretary of Housing and Economic Development Mike Kennealy and Salem Mayor Kim Driscoll to announce the filing of the administration's economic development bill, *An Act Enabling Partnerships for Growth*.
