**Baker-Polito Administration To Provide Update on Massachusetts'
Preparedness Planning for Coronavirus**

*State officials will outline preparedness steps already taken and available resources,
MA remains low risk with one confirmed case*

BOSTON – This afternoon, Governor Charlie Baker will be joined by Secretary of Health and Human Services Marylou Sudders and Commissioner of the Department of Public Health Monica Bharel to provide an update on the state's preparedness planning regarding Coronavirus.

Massachusetts remains low risk and has had one confirmed case of Coronavirus to date, and state officials continue to coordinate with the CDC and implement CDC guidance.
